



#### SECOND SUNDAY AFTER THE HOLY CROSS

#### A reading from the second letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians

Brethren, you are the temple of the living God, as God says, "I will be their God and they shall be my people" (Lv. 26:12, cf. Jer. 31:1). "Wherefore, come out from among them, be separated, says the Lord, and touch not an unclean thing" (Is. 52:1); "and I will welcome you in, and will be a Father to you, and you shall be my sons and daughters, says the Lord almighty" (Cf. Hos. 1:10; Is 43:6).

Having therefore these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of the body and of the spirit, perfecting sanctity in the fear of God.

The Lord said, "Even as you wish men to do to you, so also do you to them. And if you love those who love those who love them. And if you do good to those who do good to you, what merit have you? For even sinners do that. And if you lend to those from whom you hope to receive in return, what merit have you? For even sinners lend to sinners that they may get back as much in return. But love your enemies, and do good, and lend, not hoping for any return, and your reward shall be great, and you shall be children of the Most High, for He is kind towards the ungrateful and evil. Be merciful, therefore, even as your Father is merciful."

#### A WORD FROM THE HOLY FATHERS

#### EPISTLE: 2 CORINTHIANS 6:16 - 7:1

**RECEIVED AS CHILDREN**. AMBROSIASTER: God wants us to be set apart from all contamination so that he can receive us as his children. By this testimony Paul exhorts us to a pure life. He shows that Jesus Christ was already our Lord in ancient times and was predestined to receive us in the fondness of his love. COMMENTARY ON PAUL'S EPISTLES.

MAKE HOLINESS PERFECT. CHRYSOSTOM: Not touching unclean things is not enough to make us clean. Something else is needed for us to become holy—earnestness in faith, heedfulness and piety. HOMILIES ON THE EPISTLES OF PAUL TO THE CORINTHIANS 13.

#### GOSPEL: LUKE 6:31 - 36

**THE CUSTOM OF CHRISTIANS ONLY.** TERTULLIAN: To love friends is the custom for all people, but to love enemies is customary only for Christians. TO SCAPULA 1.

STEPHEN IS AN EXAMPLE OF LOVE FOR ENEMIES. CYPRIAN: How will you love your enemies and pray for your adversaries and persecutors? We see what happened in the case of Stephen. When he was being killed by the violence and stones of the Jews, he did not ask for vengeance but forgiveness for his murderers, saying: "O Lord, do not lay this sin against them." So it was most fitting that the first martyr for Christ who, in preceding by his glorious death the martyrs that were to come, was not only a preacher of the Lord's suffering but also an imitator of his most patient gentleness. THE GOOD OF PATIENCE 16.

THE DIVINE IMAGE SEEN IN HUMAN MERCY. ORIGEN: The traces of the divine image are clearly recognized not through the likeness of the body, which undergoes corruption, but through the intelligence of the soul. We see the divine image in its righteousness, temperance, courage, wisdom, discipline, and through the entire chorus of virtues that are present essentially in God. These can be in people through effort and the imitation of God, as also the Lord points out in the Gospel when he says, "Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful" and "Be perfect, as your Father is perfect." ON FIRST PRINCIPLES 4.10.

**MERCY ON THE JUST AND THE UNJUST**. JUSTIN MARTYR: We pray for you that you might experience the mercy of Christ. He instructed us to pray for our enemies, when he said, "Be kind and merciful, even as your heavenly Father is merciful." We can observe that almighty God is kind and merciful, causing his sun to shine on the ungrateful and on the just and sending rain to both the holy and the evil. All of them, he has told us, he will judge. DIALOGUE WITH TRYPHO 96.<sup>1</sup>
